Environment report	<p><i>External Contacts</i> <i>May</i> Nil <i>June</i> One external contact regarding dust.</p> <p><i>Noise</i> There were no noise level exceedances.</p> <p><i>Dust</i> Dust management remains a focus. All licence limits have been complied with.</p> <p><i>Water</i> Water management on site has been closely monitored with extra water in Rail Loop Dam being reused on site.</p> <p><i>Beach clean-up</i> The second beach clean-up was held on 2 June 2016 at Louisa Creek and McEwen's Beach. Collected 225.5kg of waste with the majority being steel rail tracks from McEwen's Beach. Some port identifiable waste from Louisa Creek Beach. Next clean up in September 2016.</p>		

		<p><i>Revegetation</i> The Industrial Dam spillway was recently revegetated with 1644 species of native shrubs and grasses to reduce the potential spread of weeds (mainly Leuceana) from DBCT to Sandfly Creek and to increase native vegetation on site.</p> <p><i>Additional Environment News</i> World Turtle Day fundraiser held on site Wednesday 18 May 2016. Raised \$588.00 for Mackay & District Turtle Watch Association. World Environment Day held on site Friday 3 June 2016. Overall Enviro Hero was announced, an initiative to encourage, reward and recognise environmental improvements workers implement. DBCT will again be participating in the National Tree Planting Day by assisting two groups' plant trees in Mackay.</p>
