Although the monitoring data showed a spike in dust, it was replicated by a spike in background dust. 247mm of rain fell across the terminal in the week leading up to the complaint and no issues were identified. <u>No exceedances were recorded</u></p> <p>1 noise complaint was received from Horsborough Rd.
