Our Safety Transformation Strategy is now approved, and we are currently in the process of implementing this strategy into the Terminal's business operations. Expect to receive an email from DBI in April, with a link to the 2022 Materiality Survey. The purpose of the survey is to review the Terminal's Sustainability Strategy (published in 2020), to ensure our work is relevant and targeted.
